Unfortunately, after much deliberation we have decided to **stop accepting GHI and HIP insurances (Emblem Health) starting January 1st, 2023**. The insurance plan is simply not as competitive with their reimbursement and the amount of mistakes that they make is not aligned with the standard of care that we try to provide our patients.
